Teacher's notes

Grade: 3

Language focus: Vocabulary revision / *like* and *don't like* / *adjectives*

Time (approx.): 20 minutes

Preparation: Photocopy one worksheet for each student

Using the worksheet:

- In Exercise 1 students have to add one or two letters to complete the words.
- In Exercise 2 students have to draw lines connecting the objects/activities to either *Yes, I do* or *No, I don't* to express their own opinion.
- Once students have completed Exercise 2 get them to say some of the things they like or don't like orally. Call out the names of different things and get the students to say, *I like ...* or *I don't like*
- In Exercise 3 students have to draw the pictures. This combines vocabulary with adjectives. They must read and understand the instructions in order to draw the pictures in the boxes above.

Additional ideas:

- Tell students to take a sheet of paper and draw two large squares. Under the squares they should write two short descriptions as in Exercise 3. For example, they could write, *The cat is big* or *The school is big*.
- The students then swap papers. They read the instructions and draw the pictures.
